

# Public Lecture by Dr. Reynaldo C. Ileto

In his lecture, Dr. Ileto will present a panorama of Philippine history from the late 19th century to the present, including the country's current situation. He will also touch on the continuing influence of colonial rule on the Philippines even after the nation achieved independence through the revolution of 1896 and the subsequent secession from Spain in 1898, the Filipino-American War of 1899-1902, and the Japanese occupation from 1942 to 1945. The current South China Sea dispute will be looked at from a historical point of view.

#### Lecturer: Dr. Reynaldo C. Ileto

Dr. Ileto is a historian who taught at the University of the Philippines, the Australian National University and the National University of Singapore until his retirement in 2012. He was a visiting senior scholar at Kyoto University (1991) and Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (2001). His most well-known publication, *Pasyon and Revolution: Popular Movements in the Philippines*, was translated into Japanese and published by Hosei University Press in 2005. He was the Academic Prize Laureate of the 14th Fukuoka Asian Culture Prize in 2003. In 2012, Ateneo de Manila University conferred on him its highest university award, the Gawad Tanglaw ng Lahi (Guiding Light of the Nation).

#### Dr. Hiromu Shimizu (Professor at the Center for Southeast Asian Studies, Kyoto University)

Dr. Shimizu is a graduate of the University of Tokyo and received his MA and PhD (Sociology) from the same institute. He was an associate professor of the College of General Education at Kyushu University, a visiting professor of the Beijing Center for Japanese Studies at Beijing Foreign Studies University, and a professor of the Graduate School of Social and Cultural Studies at Kyushu University.
